Adam David Flowers, age 41, of Dunbar, passed away Friday, September 2, 2022 after a fall at home.

Adam was preceded in death in 2020 by his brother, Brad Michael Flowers, and was devastated just three months later by the loss of his wife, Alison Gunter Flowers.
