“ My earliest memory of Andy is when she and I both attended the Presbyterian Chapel in Chemical City, the St. Albans suburb community that she grew up in. I remember when her mother carried Andrea as an infant in her arms to church, while her two younger brothers (Rick a.k.a. Wayne, and Ronald) tagged along or ran ahead. She was 11 years my junior and I taught both of her brothers in Sunday School later. Upon occasion, Andy's Sunday School teacher was out sick and her class would combine with mine, when her older brother was in my class. I remember her as being a relatively quiet, small child, cute as a button, and overshadowed by her active, funny, and outspoken older brother. But later on, her own wit and wry sense of humor surfaced and she was fun to talk to.

Later in life, Andy reflected the hard work ethic of her parents, especially her mother, for whom she cared during Shirley's waning health. I am saddened at her untimely death, but I hope her children and other family members will keep good memories alive and learn valuable lessons from this sad experience.
