Arthur Jackson (Jack) Byrd, Jr., 77, of St. Albans, West Virginia, passed away on Monday, May 5, 2025 at Cabell-Huntington Hospital following a battle with Pulmonary Fibrosis.

Born in 1947, Arthur was the son of the late Arthur Jackson Byrd, Sr. and Janis Josephine Angela Wiseman Byrd. A 1965 graduate of St. Albans High School, he went on to serve his country honorably as a US Army veteran during the Vietnam era, stationed in Korea.

Arthur retired from Verizon after many years of dedicated service, where he built lifelong friendships and earned the respect of all who worked alongside him. A devoted Christian and strong follower of Jesus, Arthur's faith was a guiding force throughout his life.

He was known in the community not only for his kind heart but also for his love of old cars and trucks. He was a regular sight around town behind the wheel of his beloved 1947 Ford pickup truck.

Arthur was preceded in death by his wife of 49 years, Linda Lou Byrd. He is survived by his daughter, Kimberly Beavers (Tim); his son, AJ Byrd; his sisters, Suzie and Becky; and his brother, Mark. He also leaves behind many cherished extended family members and friends.
