Bill Muck, 84, of Cross Lanes, WV, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, May 18, 2024.

He was born in Charleston to the late Billy R. Muck, Sr., and Mary Magdalene Whiting Muck.

He was employed at Fike Chemical Company from 1959-1988. Bill and his wife Sara founded Colonial Interiors in 1980, where he continued to work until his death. He was a member of Cross Lanes United Methodist Church.

He was a graduate of Nitro High School, class of 1959. He held multiple degrees from West Virginia State College that he obtained over the course of 30 years while working full-time and raising his family.

He was a “car guy” who loved his Pontiacs. He was an active member of Nitro Antique Car Club, as well as a few other car clubs.

Surviving is his supportive wife of 60 years, Sara Dorsey Muck; daughter, Martha Hannah (John); son, Matthew Muck (Karrie); brother, Charles Muck (Carolyn) and sister Shirley Rollins. Also surviving are his two grandsons, Zachary Hannah (Payton) and Fletcher Muck (Tristan).

A memorial service will be held at 12:00 p.m. Friday, May 24, 2024, at Bartlett-Nichols Funeral Home, St. Albans with J. F. Lacaria officiating.

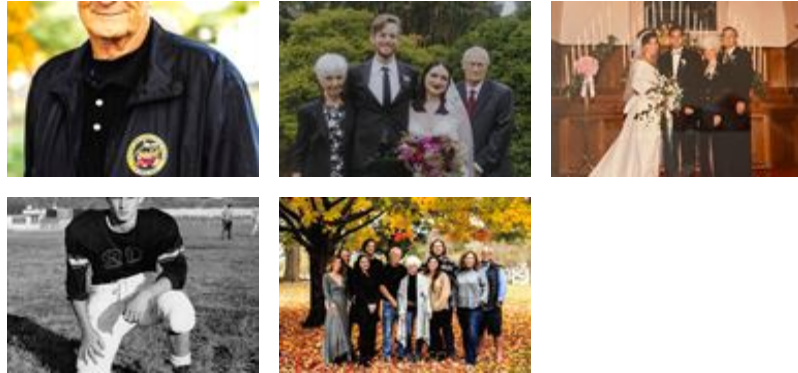
