October 13, 1966 - May 9, 2019

Surrounded by family, Cameron M. Harman, 52, of St. Albans went home to be with Jesus on Thursday, May 9, 2019 at the Genesis Center in Teays Valley after a courageous battle with glioblastoma.

Born October 13, 1966, he was the son of the late Danny and Alice Harman of St. Albans.

He was a graduate of Nitro High School, Class of 1984, and a graduate of West Virginia State University. He served the community with his business, Newbrough Photography, for 30 years. He was a member at Maranatha Fellowship in St. Albans for many years, and recently a member of Kingdom Life Fellowship in Nitro. He loved to fish, spend time at his family camp, make people laugh, share his testimony of faith, and capture all of life's moments on camera. But above all, he loved Jesus and he loved his family.

He is survived by his children Mitchell Harman of Morgantown, Franklin Harman, Ellyne Harman, and their mother Cindy Harman all of St. Albans. He is also survived by his siblings Gale Harman (Jodie) of Tornado, Matt Harman and former sister-in-law Lorrie of St. Albans, Marshall Cerullo of Buckhannon, and Jennifer Knapp of Savannah, GA. He was blessed with 22 nieces and nephews and many loving aunts, uncles, and cousins. Brother Ed Connors, Bernie Henaghan, Jamie Parker, Matt Matheny, and Ethan Poole

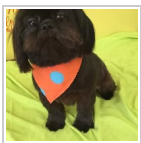
