Charles William Eshenaur, 82, went home to be with our Lord and Savior on December 25, 2023. He was surrounded by his loving family at Hubbard Hospice House in Charleston, WV.

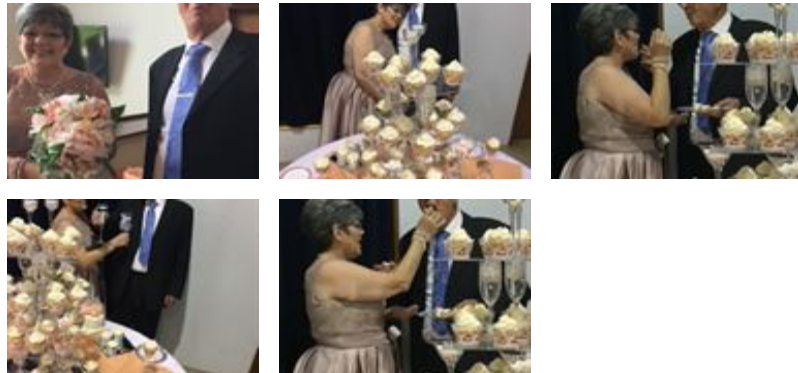

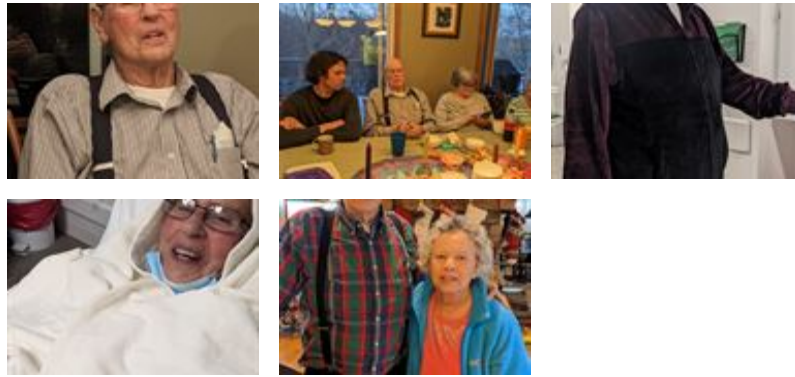

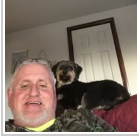
