Cline Everet Larck passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 31, 2026, at his home in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Cline was born on July 26, 1945, in Scott Depot, West Virginia, to the late Houston Beal Larck and Clara Larck. He was also preceded in death by his beloved wife, Connie Morrison Larck, and his sister, Pauline Blackburn.

Cline married his high school sweetheart, Connie Morrison of St. Albans, West Virginia, on August 17, 1968 and they spent the majority of their married life living in Nitro. A graduate and lifetime football fan of Winfield High School, Cline dedicated his professional career to South Putnam Public Service District, where he served as Chief Operator until his retirement.

Cline was a devoted husband, father, and faithful member of Bethany Baptist Church. He will be fondly remembered for his dedication to church life, particularly for organizing countless church outings.

Beyond his professional and church commitments, Cline embraced life through his many interests. He had a deep appreciation for the art of glass blowing, beginning with his work at Hamon Glass in the late 1960s. He also loved fishing, or at least telling fish stories. Some of his most cherished memories were family trips to Myrtle Beach, where he enjoyed the ocean and

the tradition of returning year after year with those he loved.

Cline is survived by his children, Carrie Wunner (Dave) and Christopher Larck (Clara); his grandchildren, Jason and Kevin Wunner; sister-in-law, Myra Kaye Morrison as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and great-nieces and great-nephews.
