Edsel "Papa" Youell Taylor, 92, of St. Albans passed away on Thursday, September 28, 2023.

Edsel was born on September 17th, 1931 in Pentacre, West Virginia to Joseph and Rada Taylor. He is preceded in death by his sisters Eva Taylor, Chloe (Ernest) Lowery, Virginia (Jack) Booth, and Gloria (Jim) Lyons, and a brother, Crandal.
