Elizabeth Carole "Carolyn" Coppala, of St. Albans, passed away peacefully in the hospital after a short illness on Monday, February 24, 2020.

She graduated from Lenoir High School in Lenoir, North Carolina, and attended The Presbyterian Hospital School of Nursing in Charlotte, North Carolina, from which she graduated in 1959, receiving a three year RN degree. She met the love of her life, George Harrill Coppala, while working at The Presbyterian Hospital and caring for Harrill's terminally ill father.

Carolyn was a wife, homemaker and mother while her children were growing up and later worked as a nurse in private practice, ultimately retiring from Dunbar Medical Associates in Dunbar, West Virginia. She loved to cook and was an excellent cook, and also loved to sew, even doing so into her 80's. When she was younger she enjoyed playing basketball and was the captain of her high school basketball team, played tennis, and had many hobbies, including various crafts. husband, George Harrill Coppala, as well as many family members and friends.
