Gary D. Austin, 77, of Charleston, WV passed away on Saturday, October 28, 2023.

He was a graduate of Charleston High School, class of 1964, where he was awarded Mr. West Virginia Future Business Leaders of America. He earned a B.S. from Morris Harvey College and an M.B.A. in finance and accounting from West Virginia College of Graduate Studies. Gary spent 37 years in the banking industry where he served as President of Peoples Bank of Richwood and Regional President of First Community Bank. He also worked at Kanawha Valley Bank and Chemical Bank and Trust. In addition to his banking career, he worked at the accounting and consulting firm, Arnett and Foster. He volunteered to serve on the boards of several charities in WV. Gary was a veteran of the United States Army and attended Bible Center Church.
