Hobart Graham Shrewsbury, (89), of St Albans, WV, went to be with the Lord June 17, 2024, after a short illness.

Graham, also fondly known as “Shrews,” was born on October 16, 1934, in Charleston, WV. After graduating from St Albans High School, he went on to study Engineering at West Virginia Tech, then enlisted in the Army where he served in the field artillery during the Korean War. After serving his country, he finished his studies to become a Certified Civil Professional Engineer and worked for various engineering firms in the Kanawha Valley. He was also a real estate developer responsible for creating the Shrewsbury Heights subdivision in St Albans.

Graham loved the outdoors and spent a lot of weekends hunting, fishing, camping, and canoeing with his son David, who was also his best friend. He enjoyed photography, golfing, was an avid student of the Bible and a faithful member of the Grace Baptist Temple in St Albans. There were many years where he volunteered as a little league football, basketball, and baseball coach. It was his greatest pleasure to see young athletes grow and improve under his tutelage.

Graham is survived by the love of his life, Lois, his daughter Jonie McGraw and her husband John McGraw; grandchildren Daniel McGraw (Calli), David

McGraw, Nathan McGraw; and two grandchildren Jack and Natalie McGraw. He was preceded in death by his son David Shrewsbury and his sister Jane Shrewsbury.
