We are saddened to announce the unexpected passing of Jason Wayne Simms, 47, of Huntington formerly of Gallipolis Ferry. On Friday, March 17, 2023, he was fatally injured in a vehicle accident.

Jason was preceded in death by his father, Jerry Wayne Simms "Yoda".

Jason was a 1993 graduate of Saint Albans High School.
