Jimmie G. "Jim" Call, 91, of Huntington, formerly of St. Albans, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, February 23, 2022 with his family by his side.

He was born in Barboursville to the late Leslie and Virginia Call. He was also preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy Mae "Dottie" Head Call and brother, John Call.

Jim worked in banking for many years, having started his career with Charleston National Bank, then Bank of St. Albans and retiring as president from One Valley Bank, Huntington.
