The kindness and generosity of her parents were formative for Linda. As a teenager, Linda worked at a five and dime, and she typically used her earnings to purchase gifts for family members. She graduated from Stonewall Jackson High School in 1961. After graduating high school, Linda worked as a receptionist at American Casualty Insurance and underwent training as an insurance underwriter. Following that, she went to work for McDonough-Caperton. In 1963, she met the love of her life and best friend, Tom Gunnoe, at a dance at Glenville College. They were married on May 29, 1964. Following the birth of her first child, Tonya, Linda became a full-time, stay-at-home mom.

Linda and Tom were partners in every way, and they were an integral part of the Sun Valley community where they resided for over 50 years. Their mutual love, respect and devotion were deep and steadfast. They shared a love and commitment to family and enjoyed reunions, holiday gatherings, after church meals and any other time spent with family. Linda was a remarkable cook, and every Christmas Eve she prepared an amazing spread of delicious foods for her family. Her bacon wrapped water chestnut recipe lives on to this day. They and their children enjoyed many weekends at their camp on the

Greenbrier River, where Linda enjoyed flower and berry picking. Linda had a special bond and devotion to her siblings, Jean and Steve, and she was close with her sister-in-law, Charmaine, and her husband, Bill. Linda and Tom were talented dancers, and they often would cut a rug in the living room to music of Chuck Berry and other songs of their youth. Their granddaughter Leah, whom Linda loved fully and deeply, inherited her Gran's dancing talent.

Linda grew beautiful flowers, and she enjoyed walking the woods to admire wildflowers. Often, she would lead a group of neighborhood kids to the "swamp" to pick violets and daisies. Her family will always think of her when they see a bouquet of violets. Linda was creative and artistic. She made remarkable Halloween costumes, and Tonya and Brent won many "best costume" prizes. She loved quilting, and her lovely and warm quilts are spread far and wide in the homes of loved ones. Her neighbor, Norma Bartlett, was a talented artist, and Linda felt fortunate to live across the street from her dear friend. Linda was an accomplished Bridge player, and her monthly Bridge Club Night gave her great joy, mainly because of the opportunity to visit with her friends. It must be noted that Linda also held a deep fondness for cows and ice cream. She loved to watch the former in a field and eat the latter.

Linda Gunnoe was kindhearted, unselfish, and devoted to helping family and friends. She was a beautiful person in every way. Her passing will leave a void in the hearts of those that knew and loved her. Her life is an inspiration.

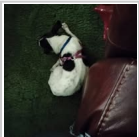
