She graduated from Secretarial Program at West Virginia Rehabilitation Center in 1961. She retired from the Division of Rehabilitation on June 30, 2007 with over 27 years of service.

Linda was a lifelong Christian and a member of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in St. Albans where she had been a member of the Women's Club and a member of the St. Francis School PTA.

On November 27, 1965, she married John L.
