Martha Hughes Callaway, 101, of St. Albans formerly of Beckley went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 at Charleston Gardens, Charleston.

She was born at Beckley to the late James David and Amelia Small Hughes.

She was also preceded in death by her husband, Charles Clinton Callaway and several sisters and brothers.

Martha retired from Dr. Pepper/7Up Bottling Company. She was a long time member of the First Baptist Church of Beckley and later transferred her membership to the First Baptist Church of St. Albans. She taught Sunday school classes, was the superintendent of the Juniors Department, very active in the ABWM and was a member of the Gideon's Auxiliary and one of the oldest members of the Gideon's serving since the mid 50's.

Surviving are her loving son and daughter-in-law, Dick and Libby Callaway, granddaughters, Amy Wagner (John) and Teresa Warner (Michael); 7 great grandchildren and 4 great great grandchildren.

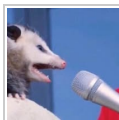
