Miriam Conroy, 72, of Saint Albans, died Thursday, February 21, 2019 at CAMC General Hospital in Charleston, WV

Miriam was born August 10, 1946 in Alliance, OH to Thomas C. Wright and Elizabeth Wright (nee Gerino). She was the middle child of three girls. Possessing an infectious smile, a loving personality, and an insatiable passion for the arts, Miriam was everyone's sweetheart and made friends easily, regardless of others' stations in life. She graduated from Penn State University with a Bachelor's Degree in Fine Arts in 1969. She began her 25-year graphic arts career at Pittsburgh PBS station WQED, where she worked in set design for Mr. Rogers' Neighborhood. She continued her professional life as a meeting planner, where she coordinated the West Virginia Governor's Summit on Aging and numerous other senior advocacy conferences. Miriam was also a twenty-year volunteer of local, state, and national elections—a civic duty she enjoyed.
