Paul T. Hendricks, 90, of Tornado went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, November 3, 2022 at his residence.

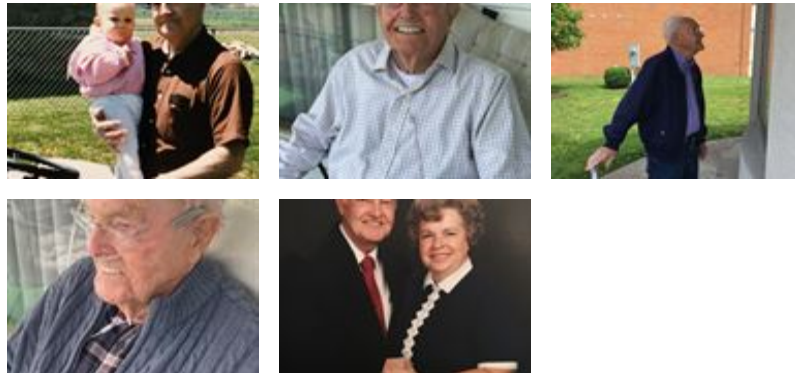
