“ That is a one of the most difficult texts I'm trying to write not only because of my insufficient English but because Reggie's parents Janet and Doug are my precious friends. When our child goes before us it is unspeakably... outrageously wrong. Yes, just wrong. The parents feel hurt and cheated, and disappointed. Now they stand before the next hard test: to learn to be grateful that Reggie came along at all, knowing at the same time that life without him will be very difficult.

I witnessed how selflessly Janet and Doug were taking care of their son when he got sick in the last years. They gave up their own life, their own home and beds... They were day and night staying at Reggie's in order to make his life easier, they were sleeping on uncomfortable sofa just to be closer to him in case he needs help. When I met Reggie the first time, he was a healthy, handsome man with a soft, quiet voice. And so was also his personality: kind and soft. I met him mainly in Janet's house when we had a family gathering for Christmas or Easter. I was just the addition to the family. One time, after spending a day shopping and dining with Janet, she drove me to my house. When I left her car I saw another car that stopped behind her and kept honking the horn. Janet was busy organizing her shopping bags in the car so she didn't pay attention to the noise. I was laughing because I recognized Reggie who was driving home from the golf course. He finally put his head out of the window and yelled jokingly: “Look, Krys, mom is pretending not to know me!”

Well, Reggie, there isn't anyone who would like to pretend not to know you. I am happy to have made your acquaintance even if it was for only ten years.
