Robert (“R.J.”, “Bob”) Knopf ,91, of St Albans, passed away on Feb 9 under the care of hospice. Born in West New York, NJ on April 18, 1932 to George and Henrietta Knopf. Attending Gettysburg College, he went on to earn his PhD in Organic Chemistry from Princeton University & following graduation received his commission as 2nd Lt in the Army. Married & had 3 children (subsequently divorced). Retired from Union Carbide Corporation after nearly 29 years, having risen to level of Sr. Development Scientist in Organic and Polymer Chemistry and wrote numerous patents. After early retirement he chose to work with his Daughter-in-Law in her mattress warehouse business. Worshipped at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church in St. Albans, which merged to become Cross of Grace Lutheran Church in Hurricane. His interests included singing in the church choir and Kanawha Kordsmen, both square and ballroom dancing, solving crossword puzzles, and was an avid reader. Predeceased in death by his brother (Gene), wife (Mary Jane Dorsey Knopf). He is survived by his 3 loving children (Kenneth Knopf, Kim Nicholas, Katherine Foster) their spouses, 10 grandchildren, and 6 great-grandchildren. Funeral Services will be conducted Monday, February 12th, 11am at Bartlett-Nichols Funeral Home. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at the funeral home.
