He was born on December 8, 1987, in Charleston to Daniel Ryder and Melissa Casto Bays.

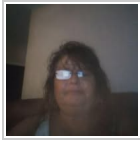
He is preceded in death by his mother Melissa Bays; and uncle, Earl Ryder.
