Theodore Paul "Ted" Traube, 88, of St. Albans went home to be with the Lord on Monday, July 1, 2024, at his residence.

He was born in Queen Shoals, West Virginia to the late Ernest and Kathleen Martha Graham Traub. He was also preceded in death by his grandson, Joe Roche; sisters, Helen Sutton and Betty Tawney; brother, Alfred "Eddie" Traub and infant sister, Debra Lynn Traub.
