Virginia Louise "Ginny" Dryden, 93, of St. Albans, WV passed away peacefully on Saturday, March 29, 2025, at the home of her son Paul.

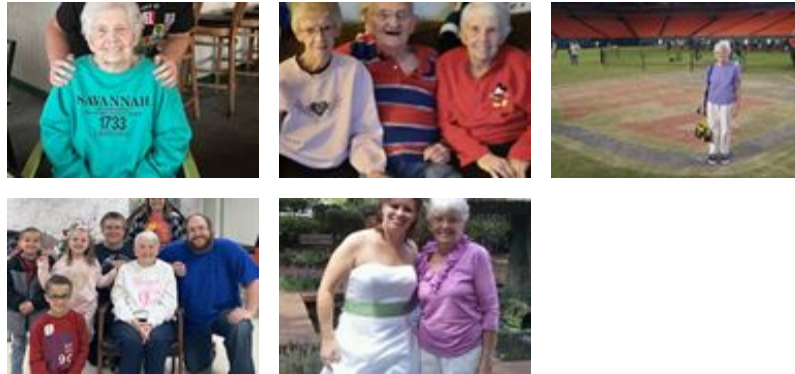
